Australia Awards

Australia Awards are prestigious international scholarships funded by the Australian government offering the next generation of Indonesian leaders an opportunity to undertake study, research and professional development in Australia. The scholarships cover tuition fees, travel allowance, establishment allowance, monthly stipend, health insurance and travel insurance.

Indonesia Endowment Fund for Education/Lembaga Pengelola Dana Pendidikan (LPDP)

LPDP scholarships provide gifted Indonesians with funding for Master and PhD studies abroad, including in Australia. The scholarships offer travel allowance, tuition fees, establishment allowance and living allowance.

Eligible institutions include the Australian National University; University of Melbourne; University of Sydney; University of Queensland; University of New South Wales; Monash University; University of Western Australia; University of Adelaide; Macquarie University; RMIT University; Curtin University; University of Wollongong; University of Newcastle; Queensland University of Technology; and, the University of Technology Sydney. Other universities may be considered by LPDP on a case by case basis.

Other Indonesian Government Scholarships

DIKTI Scholarships

The DIKTI scholarships are a pathway to PhD studies in Australia that are open to current and prospective faculty members at Indonesian universities and staff employed by DIKTI or Indonesian state universities. The scholarships are fully funded, including travel allowance, tuition fees, establishment allowance and stipend.

The Ministry of Religious Affairs Ministry Scholarships

The Ministry of Religious Affairs' "5,000 Doctors" scholarship program is targeted at lecturers from Islamic educational institutions looking to achieve a PhD. The scholarships cover tuition fees, living allowance, settlement allowance and more. Eligible institutions include the University of Canberra; Western Sydney University; Deakin University; Flinders University; Victoria University; Murdoch University; Notre Dame University; University of Western Australia; Curtin University; Queensland University of Technology; RMIT University; University of South Australia; and, the University of Technology Sydney.
